The present study is conducted to evaluate and analyze the content analysis of NAAC accredited 'A, A+ and A++' library websites in Maharashtra. Study concludes that maximum library websites are enriching with Information About Library, Contact, E-mail, Books, Journals, Thesis, Dissertation, Audio/Video/CD/DVD, OPAC, Reprographic Service, E-Books, E-Journals. In this study, it is found that Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University library website is best library websites among the University libraries in Maharashtra.

Universities are providing higher education in various disciplines in India. All these universities come under four types like Central University, State University, deemed to be university and Private University. NAAC accredited five 'A, A+ and A++' grade university

is the best university. The libraries of these universities are providing various library services to its user. Those libraries provide different library services to its user either offline or online via their own website. Now a days websites are becoming increasingly important for college as support for teachers, administrators, counselors, students, parents, and the community. They can obtain their desired information from the websites any where, anytime. Researchers are depending on web based resources for their academic and research activities. Many universities trying to disseminate the variety of information to their users through web sites such as digital reference services; online inter library loan, tutorials, library collection, library services, E-Resources, OPAC, rules and regulations, etc. Therefore, conducting content analysis certainly benefits the university website in general and library websites in particular to develop a sturdy and strong website, which cater the information need of net users.

Content analysis is a qualitative research tool or technique widely used to analyze content and its features. It is an approach used to quantify qualitative information by sorting data and comparing different pieces of information to summarize it into useful information. Content analysis is a kind of subject analysis based on the content available on the websites. University websites are increasingly used for a wide variety of purposes, which is describes earlier. Therefore, there is necessity and desire to know about websites of universities and its libraries. In this context, content analysis study is being conducted.

Significance of the study

The study investigates the contents analysis of the five 'A, A+ and A++' grade university library website of state universities of Maharashtra. The library websites of these state universities' help their users provide relevant literature/material/ services and serve as a vital platform for marketing the information products and services of the university libraries.

Objective of the Study

The study aims to determine the information context on the web portal of libraries of the Universities in Maharashtra, accredited 'A, A+ and A++' grade by NAAC. The following objectives have been set for this study.

1. To find out general information available in the university library websites.
2. To find out the availability of services and facilities at the university libraries websites.
3. To find out the availability of library

collection and E-Resources at the university libraries websites.

4. To identify, whether the library web portal smake provision for Web OPAC.
5. To identify the differentiating factors available at the websites in the studied Universities in Maharashtra.
6. To suggest measures for the improvement of university library websites.

Research Methodology and Scope

The data has been collected through observation from the five websites of the university libraries of India, namely Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Mumbai University, Mumbai, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune, Smt. N.D.T. Women's University, Mumbai and Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. The content was evaluated on the basis of prepared checklist from selected library websites and analysis was done semantically. The quantitative rating system 0 and 1 adapted to determine presence of things on library website. If the content Present on websites, the 1 has been taken for evaluation (Yes=1) and 0 means then content not present on websites (No=0). The system of using 0 and 1 makes easy data analysis and provides quantitative result.

Data Analysis and Interpretation

The Table 1 shows the name and year of establishment of the State Universities covered in the present study. It also depicts the different URLs of selected websites of institutions and their libraries. The link of Savitribai Phule Pune

Findings

On the basis of predefined checklist, the present study was carried out of content analysis of library websites of NAAC Accredited five 'A, A+ and A++' grade state university in Maharashtra. There are some merits and demerits are found during the data analysis and interpretation. The findings of the study are as under:

1. A total numbers of five unversities are accredited 'A, A+ and A++' grade by NAAC in Maharashtra State.
2. Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune (SPPUP) was not retrieved properly at the time of evaluation of websites.
3. Most of libraries web page is link to the University Home page with the name of Knowledge Resource Center, Central Library and Link with Facilities.
4. About library, Objectives, Library hours, Library Rules and regulation, News and Event, membership, contact address, E-mail and Phone/Mob. Numbers are most informative content that the libraries used.
5. Most of the library websites has mentioned Library Collection such as Books, Journals, Thesis, Dissertation and CD/DVD in their website.
6. 100% universities have mentioned OPAC and Reprographic Service. 83.33% universities have mentioned Reference Service, Internet Access Service, Reading Room, Book Lending (Issue Return), News Paper Clippings.

7. 100% library websites mentioned the information about E-Books and E-Journals. 83.33% mentioned the information about E-Database. 66.66% mentioned the information about IR and ETD.
8. Online Seminar, Outsider Membership, Maps and Visitor No. has not been mentioned by any of the university libraries.

CONCLUSION

The purpose of the study to know features of library websites of NAAC accredited five 'A, A+ and A++' grade state universities situated in Maharashtra. The content of library websites of universities was evaluated with the help of certain identified criteria. In this study, it is found that Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University library website is best library websites among the NAAC accredited universities. It is concluded that the dissemination of relevant information to its users, library should construct their own website with the maximum content, organized and systematic manner in the standard form with the help of parameters designed time to time for the purpose.
